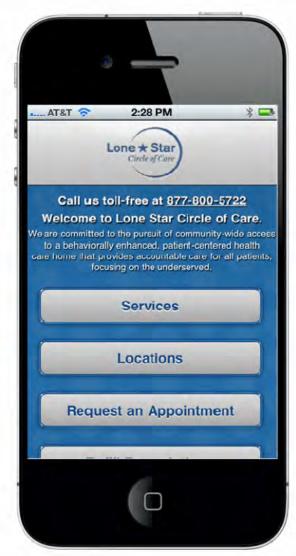

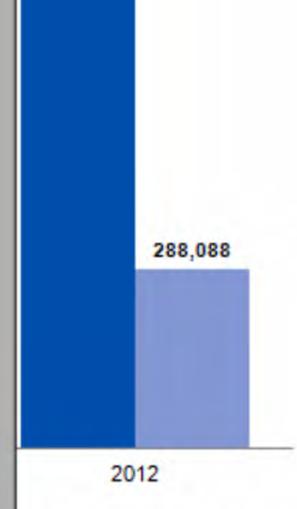

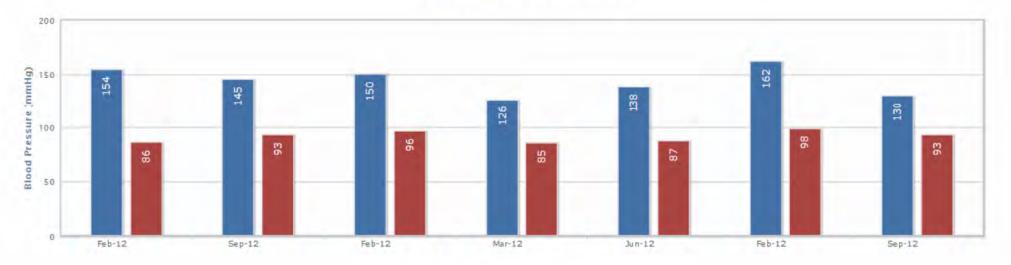

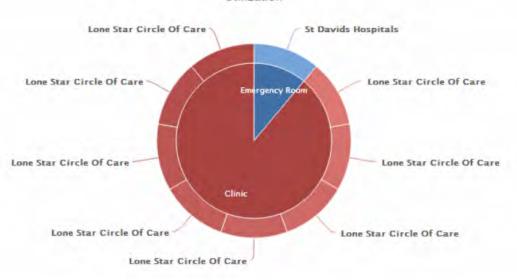
Systolic and Diastolic Blood Pressure

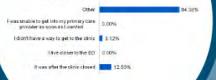

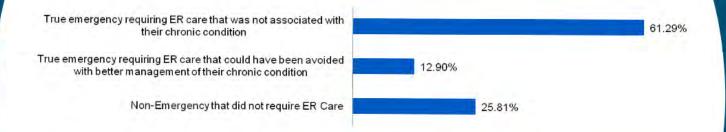

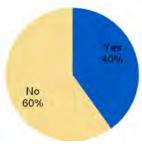

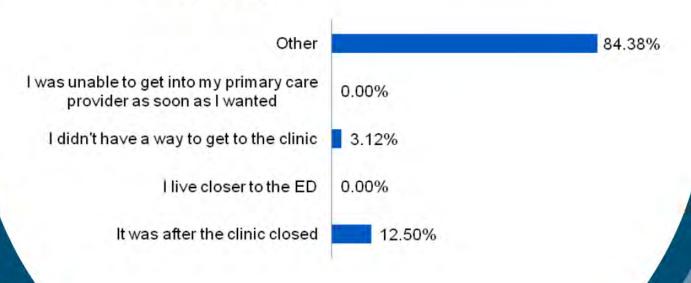

Measured Outcomes of Navigation Model





- Patients who had not had a visit to LSCC were more than four times as likely to have at least one avoidable hospital visit
- Patients who had not had a visit to LSCC were nearly twice as likely to show up in the ED
